What?

Backstage Kwandwe is a week dedicated to Kwandwe's behind-the-scenes activities, on offer for limited guests. Two fixed arrival, 3-night stays are available during the week, and participants will work alongside the Kwandwe team in an exclusive dive into keystone species conservation.

Where?

Kwandwe Private Game Reserve encompasses 22,000 hectares of pristine wilderness on either side of the Great Fish River in South Africa's Eastern Cape. Flights are available to Port Elizabeth, from where Kwandwe can be reached by road or heli.

Why?

Kwandwe's purpose as a tourism-conservation entity is to contribute sustainably to the environment, protect the incredible biodiversity of the Eastern Cape, and positively impact the surrounding communities. There are a number of procedures and activities that must take place daily in order for us to do this.

Accommodation

Stay in Ecce Lodge, a vibrant and intimate lodge with a breathtaking view of the reserve. Newly-refurbished, the décor is inspired by the beautiful surroundings and all rooms have private plunge pools and outdoor showers.

Meet the anti-poaching team and see the K9 dogs in action.



Plant spekboom and offset your carbon.



Get involved with the setting of camera traps.



Keystone species conservation through rhino darting & notching.

The Itinerary

Day 1: Thurs 19th or Sun 22nd

- Afternoon game drive
- Sundowners with Angus Sholto Douglas, Director, and an introduction to the Great Fish River Valley and the Kwandwe conservation story.

Day 2: Fri 20th or Mon 23rd

- Morning experiences:
 - Set up of rhino monitoring camera traps.
 - Spekboom planting.
 - APU dog demonstration
- Afternoon experiences:
 - Rhino walking safari
 - Demonstration of the thermal drones, Earth Ranger technology and Rouxcell collars.
 - Dinner with veterinarian Dr Will Fowlds.

Day 3: Sat 21st or Mon 24th

- Full day of rhino conservation experiences, including notching, darting and collecting DNA samples.
- Dinner with the rhino conservation team.

Day 4: Sun 22nd or Tues 25th

- Morning game drive and departure.

NB All experiences are weather dependent and the order of events may vary.
