Itinerary

(DAY 1-3 of 7)

TRAVEL

Fly from either Cape Town International Airport (CPT) or O.R. Tambo International Airport, Johannesburg (JNB) to Chief Dawid Stuurman International Airport, Gqeberha (PLZ).

Meet and greet on arrival, followed by a 2-hour road transfer to Kwandwe Private Game Reserve.

Optional upgrade: Flight transfer with Air du Cap or Helicopter transfer from Gqeberha Airport (PLZ) to Kwandwe Private Airstrip (±30 minutes).

STAY — 3 NIGHTS

One of South Africa's largest privately owned reserves, Kwandwe spans 30,000 hectares of restored wilderness with exceptionally low vehicle density and outstanding Big 5 sightings. The reserve is a leader in rhino protection and biodiversity conservation.

TRAVEL

Private charter flight from Kwandwe Private Airstrip to Mkambati Airstrip, followed by a short lodge transfer to GweGwe Lodge.

STAY — 3 NIGHTS

Set within Mkambati Nature Reserve along the Wild Coast, GweGwe offers access to dramatic coastal landscapes, rich marine ecosystems, and meaningful cultural connection in one of South Africa's most remote destinations.

DAY 4 – 6

EXPERIENCES

- Hiking, cycling, and guided nature drives
- Kayaking, canoeing, and SUP
- Marine walks and snorkeling
- Shore-based whale watching (Jun–Oct)
- Sardine Run (mid-Jun to mid-Jul)
- Community and cultural engagement

The lodge offers nine suites, including family accommodation, each with private deck and ocean views.

DEPARTURE

Seat-in charter flight (Mon & Fri) or private charter from Mkambati Airstrip to King Shaka International Airport (DUR), connecting with onward flights.
