Warden who led the brave wildlife rescue effort Operation Noah, Fothergill is a unique water and land based safari experience that is perfectly sandwiched between Hwange National Park and Mana Pools.

Operation Noah was carried out between 1959 and 1964 after the completion of the Kariba dam wall. As the water levels started to rise, thousands of animals were stranded on small islands that were disappearing as the lake grew. Fothergill, together with a dedicated team, staged a rescue operation that safely relocated over 6,000 wild animals into an area that later became Matusadona National Park.

Today Matusadona is under the management of African Parks and Fothergill is a designated concession in the Park, which at certain times of the year becomes an island. But for most of the year Fothergill is blessed with a kilometre-wide, iconic drowned-forest shoreline that brings in large herds of elephants, buffalo and plains game together with opportunistic predators. The safari activities are diverse and perfectly suited for more active and adventurous travellers, from big game walking and game drives to fishing, boating and river exploring.

The Zimbabwean born owners of Fothergill both have a passion for protecting wild spaces while providing sustainable futures for the people of Zimbabwe.

Managed by African Parks, this National Park is undergoing an exciting reintroduction of iconic species like cheetah and black rhino.



The Impact of Your Stay

Matusadona National Park is managed by African Parks and the Zimbabwe Parks and Wildlife Management Authority, in a partnership called the Matusadona Conservation Trust. The Trust aims to revive the national park and position it as a leading safari destination that offers exceptional game viewing from both the land and water, and one that benefits people and wildlife for generations to come.

The Fothergill team are 100% behind the Trust's objectives. The property contributes to conservation through funding, as well as responsible practices such as sustainable sport fishing and the complete implementation of a solar-energy-driven infrastructure. Stringent fishery and water-based activity controls are in place and Fothergill also assists with anti-poaching efforts, in cooperation with and under the direction of, African Parks and law enforcement.

Every stay contributes through:

- Fothergill believes strongly in the worldwide need for responsible action regarding our planet and the quality of life for future generations of people and wildlife, and everything they do, from activities to the lodge offering, supports this stance.
- Paying \$75 Conservation, Parks and Tourism Levy per person per night (\$35 for children), a portion of which is contributed to
 the Trust and the community engagement initiatives, tourism promotion, and the restoration of wildlife populations through
 reintroductions of indigenous animals.
- By merit of staying at Fothergill, guests are supporting tourism promotion in the area and the establishment of Matusadona as a prime safari destination.
- Supporting the training and skills development of the local Zimbabwean team, all of whom start as apprentices, straight from school, and receive training from Fothergill in the Guide Academy that focuses on a variety of vocations, not only guiding. Throughout this process, the trainees are paid.
- Choosing to stay at a lodge with the highest environmental and philanthropic credentials, including:
 - o 95% of Fothergill's energy requirements are fuelled by solar power.
 - Sustainable activities such as catch-and-release sport fishing.
- Supporting the area's anti-poaching efforts, in collaboration with, and under the direction of, African Parks and law enforcement.
