GENERAL INFORMATION	
CLASSIFICATION	<i>PREMIER</i> : 1 exclusive use camp. Open June – mid March. Privately owned and operated by Nomad Tanzania.
LAND RELATIONSHIP	Sand Rivers and Kiba Point occupy prime wildlife-rich land operating under a special concession granted by TANAPA (Tanzania National Parks Authority).
OVERVIEW	Located along a secluded stretch of the Rufiji River in Nyerere National Park. Kiba Point is a private retreat with four open-fronted suites, private guiding, and tailor-made boat and game drives, reflecting Nomad’s signature blend of comfort and immersive wildlife.
IMPACT OF YOUR STAY	LOW MEDIUM <i>HIGH</i> VERY HIGH Nomad Tanzania actively supports local communities and conservation, which provides finance, logistics, and advice to trusted grassroots partners. With this support, initiatives include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lifelong Learning: Apprenticeships, scholarships, and school support, including a meal-a-day programme reaching over 1 000 children across 12 schools.• Health & Well-being: Mobile medical and dental clinics hosted at Nomad camps.• Conservation & Environment: Assistance with anti-poaching patrols, environmental clean-ups, and conservation logistics.• Guests may also Pack for a Purpose, bringing useful supplies that benefit community projects during their visit.
ACCESS	Fly daily to Kiba Airstrip from Dar (2.5 hrs), Zanzibar (2.5 hrs), or Ruaha (1.5 hrs). 20-minute game drive to camp.
CAMPS	Exclusive use 4 open-front cottages, 1 with a child's bedroom attached. Base rate.
CHILDREN	5+ years. Only children over 12yrs are allowed to take part in walking safaris and fly camping.
HEALTH	Malaria protection is advised. Yellow fever certificate required if arriving from risk areas. Remote location with basic medical kit; medical rescue included in trip cost.

<i>A tropical savanna climate with warm temperatures year-round, distinct wet and dry seasons, and moderate humidity.</i>			
JANUARY – MARCH 24 – 33°C 75 – 91°F Wet season: Afternoon storms, lush greenery, dispersed wildlife, superb birding with migratory species.	APRIL – JUNE 22 – 30°C 72 – 86°F Rains ease, vegetation thins, game viewing improves, warm layers needed.	JULY – SEPTEMBER 18 – 29°C 64 – 84°F Dry season: Clear skies, low humidity, sparse vegetation, wildlife gathers at Rufiji River.	OCTOBER – DECEMBER 22 – 33°C 72 – 91°F Late season: Hotter days, short rains, dramatic skies, strong wildlife viewing early on.



Game Drive Vehicle Features	<p>Three pin plug sockets & USB charging points.</p>
Guided Safari Walks	<p>Get closer to the ground and observe smaller details of the bush.</p> <p>1 armed guide. Max 6 guests per walk. Guests 12+ years.</p>
Fly-Camping	<p>A longer walking safari will lead you to a remote satellite camp, enjoy a candlelit dinner, and spend the night sleeping under the stars before having breakfast and returning to the main camp.</p>

- DAILY: **Zanzibar** – Kiba (2½ hrs) daily & frequent with Auric & Safari Airlink.
- DAILY: **Ruaha** – Kiba (1½ hrs) daily & frequent with Auric, Safari Airlink & Coastal

GETTING FROM KIBA AIRSTRIP

DEPARTURE:

- DAILY: Kiba – **Dar** (2½ hrs) daily & frequent with Auric, Safari Airlink & Coastal.
- DAILY: Kiba – **Zanzibar** (2½ hrs) daily & frequent with Auric & Safari Airlink.
- DAILY: Kiba – **Ruaha** (1½ hrs) daily & frequent with Auric, Safari Airlink Coastal
