GENERAL INFORMATION

CLASSIFICATION	CLASSIC: 1 camp. Official Opening: 15 December 2025 Open: All year. Privately managed by Nomad Tanzania
LAND RELATIONSHIP	Located within Serengeti National Park, operating under TANAPA (Tanzania National Parks Authority)
OVERVIEW	Set among rocky outcrops and acacia woodland, it sits along the path of the Great Migration during calving season, offering front-row access to dramatic wildlife action and intense predator activity. Far from the crowds, Kusini is ideal for unhurried game drives and quiet immersion in nature. With just a handful of tents, the camp delivers a wild, low-impact safari experience in one of the Serengeti’s most untouched corners.
IMPACT OF YOUR STAY	LOW MEDIUM HIGH VERY HIGH Nomad Tanzania actively supports local communities and conservation, which provides finance, logistics, and advice to trusted grassroots partners. ACCESS	Fly by scheduled or private charter flights into Southern Serengeti Airstrip, just 15 minutes from camp. Reachable by road: a 3–4 hr drive from Entamanu (via Endulen & Ndotu) or approximately 6 hrs from Arusha.
LODGES & CAMPS	6 safari tents. Per person rate.
CHILDREN	8+ years Children over 12 are permitted to go out on guided walks.
HEALTH	Malaria protection is advised. Yellow fever certificate required if arriving from risk areas. Remote location with basic medical kit; medical rescue included in trip cost

WEATHER

Temperatures are warm year-round, with cooler mornings and evenings.

JANUARY – MARCH

16 - 28°C | 61 - 82°F

CALVING SEASON – Lush plains, great birding, and high predator activity.

APRIL – MAY

8 - 22°C | 46 - 72°F

GREEN SEASON – Quiet, with occasional rain and resident wildlife.

JUNE – SEPTEMBER

15 - 28°C | 59 - 82°F

DRY SEASON – Clear skies, fewer animals, but excellent resident game.

OCTOBER – DECEMBER

20 - 32°C | 68 - 90°F

SHORT RAINS – Herds return, birdlife thrives, and predator action builds.

ROOM DESCRIPTION:

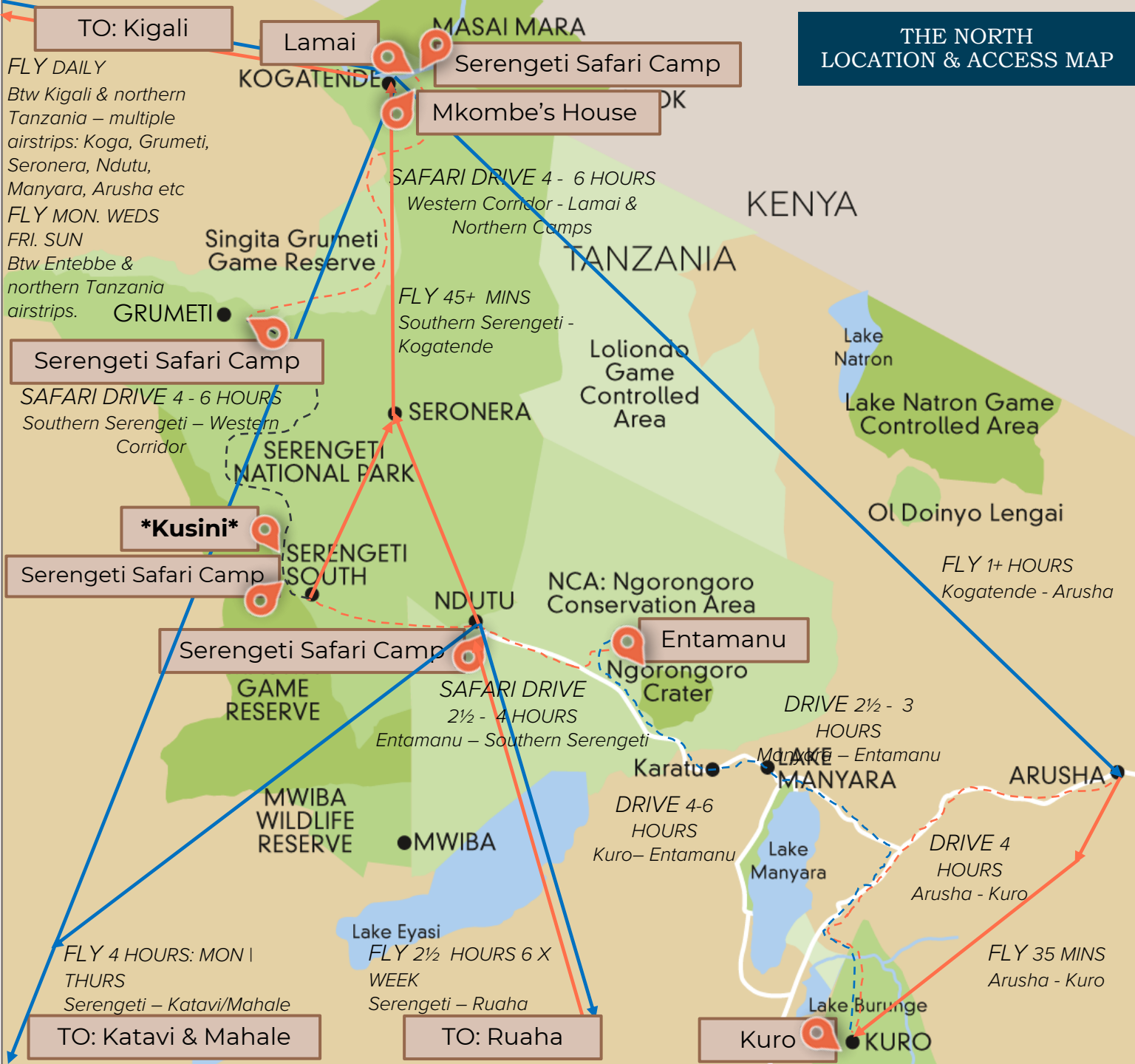
	The camp has six spacious canvas tents, each raised on wooden platforms beneath shady acacia trees. Every tent has an en-suite bathroom with flush toilet and shower, plus a private veranda for soaking in the woodland setting.
TENTSEX 6	While there is no dedicated family tent, up to two triples can be arranged in camp by adding an extra bed. Only three triples can be set up in camp at any one time. At the heart of camp is the new mess area - a comfortable and stylish space with bar and dining area, all centred around a live-on kopje that offers fantastic views across the surrounding plains and woodland.



Activities & Experiences	
Game Drives	Morning, afternoon, and evening. Open-sided vehicle (subject to availability) Max 6 per vehicle Professional safari guides.
Game Drive Vehicle Features	Three pin plug sockets & USB charging points.
Walking Safaris	Get closer to the ground as you explore the tops of ancient kopjes and notice the finer details of the bush. 1 armed Nomad scout and 1 armed ranger. Max 6 guests per walk. Guests 12+ years.
Birdwatching	Over 550 bird species make Tarangire a top birdwatching destination.
Bush Meals & Sundowners	Dine in the open with bush breakfasts, picnic lunches & sundowners.
Wildebeest Migration	Calving season (Dec–Mar)
Birding	Over 500 species recorded in the Serengeti; bird-focused guiding available.
Stargazing	Remote camp locations offer clear skies for viewing stars and constellations.

KURO – TARANGIRE

AIRSTRIP: Kuro (+ 25 min drive)

ARRIVE: Drive 4 hrs from Arusha | Fly 35 min Arusha-Kuro

DEPART: Drive 4-6 hrs to Entamanu | Fly Kuro-Serengeti daily

ENTAMANU – NGORONGORO CRATER

AIRSTRIP: Manyara (+ 2½–3 hrs drive) | Ndutu (+ 2½ hrs drive)

ARRIVE: Drive 6 hrs from Kuro | Fly 35 min Arusha-Manyara

DEPART: Drive 3-4 hrs to Southern Serengeti | Fly Manyara–Northern Serengeti daily

SERENGETI SAFARI CAMP – SOUTHERN SERENGETI

AIRSTRIP: Ndutu (+ 15 min drive) | Kusini (+ 25 min drive)

ARRIVE: Drive 2½-4 hrs from Entamanu | Multi-access flights into Ndutu/Kusini

DEPART: Drive 4-6 hrs to Western Corridor | Fly Ndutu/Kusini–Kogatende

SERENGETI SAFARI CAMP – WESTERN CORRIDOR

AIRSTRIP: Grumeti (+ 40 min drive)

ARRIVE: Drive 4-6 hrs from Southern Serengeti | Multi-access flights into Grumeti

DEPART: Drive 5-6 hrs to Northern Serengeti | Fly Grumeti-multi access

KUSINI SERENGETI – SOUTHERN SERENGETI

AIRSTRIP: Southern Serengeti (+ 15 min drive)

ARRIVE: Drive 3-4 hrs from Entamanu (via Endulen & Ndutu) | 6 hrs from Arusha | Fly scheduled or charter into Southern Serengeti

DEPART: Drive 4-6 hrs to Ndutu/Ngorongoro or Western Corridor | Fly Southern Serengeti to Ndutu, Seronera, or Lamai/Kogatende

LAMAI, MKOMBE'S & SERENGETI SAFARI CAMP – NORTHERN SERENGETI

AIRSTRIP: Kogatende (+ approx. 45 min drive)

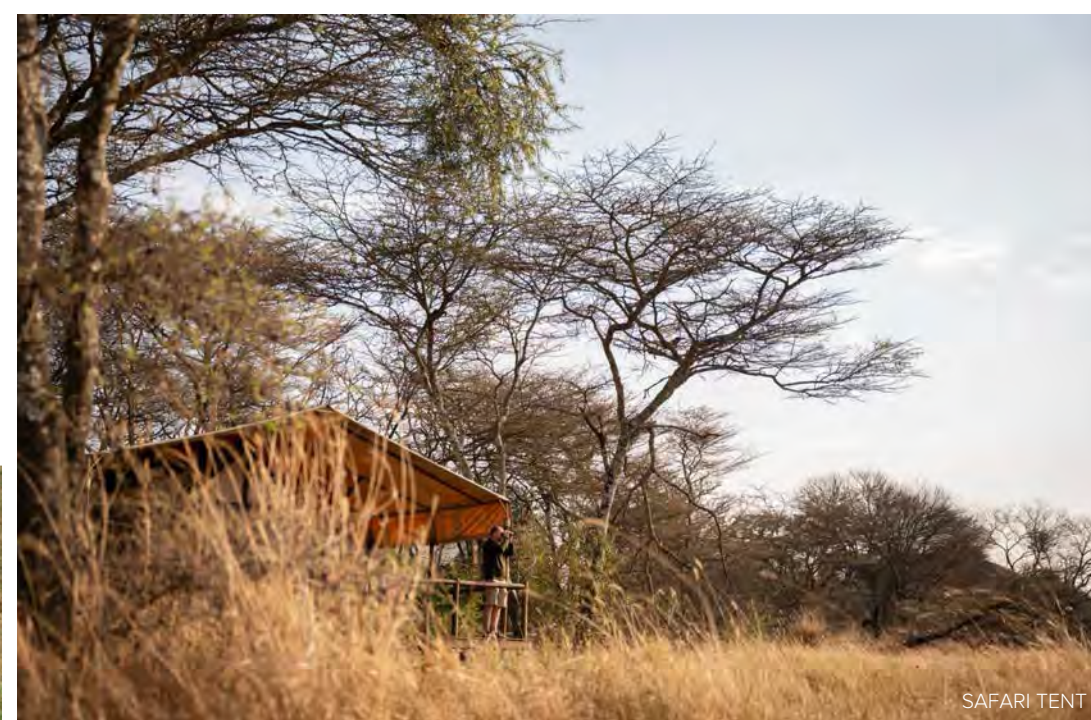
ARRIVE: Drive 4-6 hrs from Grumeti | Multi-access flights into Kogatende

DEPART: Fly Kogatende-Arusha/Kilimanjaro | Fly Kogatende-Katavi/Mahale

WEST & SOUTH TANZANIA

FLIGHTS:

- To Katavi & Mahale: Mon & Thu from Serengeti (Nomad)
- To Ruaha (Msembe): 6x per week (not Tue) from Serengeti (±2½ hrs)
- Regional: From Kenya, Rwanda, Uganda into Northern Tanzania daily | From Entebbe to Northern Serengeti 4x per week
