General Information

CLASSIFICATION	CLASSIC: 1 camp. Open from June – mid March Privately managed by Nomad Tanzania.
LAND RELATIONSHIP	Located within Tarangire National Park, operating under TANAPA (Tanzania National Parks Authority)
OVERVIEW	Kuro Camp is a small, authentic safari camp tucked into a grove of acacia trees on the banks of the Tarangire River. Its central location in Tarangire places it away from the busier northern region, giving guests exclusive access to Silale Swamp, Gursi Swamp, and the main Tarangire River. The area is renowned for its dense elephant population, and Kuro's position along the seasonal river corridor brings wildlife right to the camp. It's a hub for walking safaris, classic game drives, and quiet immersion in nature.

ACCESS	Nearest Airstrip: Kuro Airstrip (TZ08) Scheduled Flights: Several daily flights from Arusha with most domestic airlines. Approx. 10–20 minute game drive from airstrip to camp. By Road: 3.5-4 hour drive from Arusha with a private guide Scenic picnic stops and game viewing along the way. Private Charter: Available on request.
CAMP	6 safari rooms. Per person rate. 1 family safari room. Per person rate.
CHILDREN	8+ years Children 12+ are permitted to go out on guided walks.
HEALTH	Malaria protection is recommended. A yellow fever certificate is needed if you're coming from a yellow fever area. The location is remote, with a basic medical kit onsite and medical rescue included in the trip cost.

Tarangire National Park experiences warm days and cooler evenings, with dry and wet seasons influencing wildlife activity.

JANUARY – MARCH
22 - 33°C | 72 - 91°F
WET SEASON – Green landscapes and newborn wildlife.

APRIL – MAY
8 - 22°C | 46 - 72°F
Camp closed (long rains)

JUNE – SEPTEMBER
15 - 28°C | 59 - 82°F
DRY SEASON – Excellent wildlife viewing near Silale and Tarangire River.

OCTOBER – DECEMBER
20 - 32°C | 68 - 90°F
TRANSITIONAL – Great birding and increasing wildlife activity.

SAFARI ROOM X 6

Six spacious safari tents tucked under a canopy of acacia trees, thoughtfully designed with natural canvas and thatch to keep you cool and connected to the wild.

Each tent features both indoor and outdoor showers, flush toilets, and a private veranda - perfect for soaking up the views and sounds of Tarangire.

The main lounge and dining area is open-sided and inviting, styled with canvas, woven textures, and touches of vibrant colour for a relaxed yet refined safari atmosphere. 1 extra child bed (16+ yrs) per room

TWO BEDROOM SAFARI FAMILY TENT X 1

Ideal for families or small groups, the two-bedroom family tent offers a generous layout with two en-suite rooms linked by a shared covered porch.

It comfortably sleeps up to two adults and two children, or three guests in a triple setup (with at least one child or teen).

This setup allows for connection and comfort, while still offering privacy and space in the heart of nature.

GAME DRIVES	Morning, afternoon, and evening. Open-sided vehicle (subject to availability) Max 6 per vehicle Professional safari guides.
GAME DRIVE VEHICLE FEATURES	Three pin plug sockets & USB charging points.
PRIVATE VEHICLES	All bookings include a private guide and dedicated vehicle.
WALKING SAFARIS	Explore a quieter part of Tarangire on foot, often ending with a bush breakfast. 1 armed Nomad scout and 1 armed ranger. Max 6 guests per walk. Guests 12+ years.
BIRDWATCHING	Over 550 bird species make Tarangire a top birdwatching destination.
CULTURAL EXCURSIONS	Learn about Maasai culture through storytelling, language sessions, and time around the campfire.
HOT AIR BALLOONING (Extra cost)	Take to the skies at sunrise for stunning views and wildlife sightings.
ELEPHANT TREEHOUSE	A raised platform in a sausage tree near the river - great for sundowners or lazy afternoons.
BUSH DINING	Enjoy a private breakfast or dinner by the Tarangire River, reached by drive and short walk.
