CLASSIFICATION	CLASSIC: 2 mobile camps. Open all year. Privately managed by Nomad Tanzania
LAND RELATIONSHIP	Located within Serengeti National Park, operating under TANAPA (Tanzania National Parks Authority) and Ngorongoro Conservation Area NCAA.
OVERVIEW	Serengeti Safari Camp features two mobile tented camps that follow the Great Migration, moving to prime spots for wildlife highlights like river crossings and calving. Intimate and low-impact, the camps blend into the landscape, offering authentic safaris with expert guides and close-up encounters.
IMPACT OF YOUR STAY	LOW MEDIUM HIGH VERY HIGH Nomad Tanzania actively supports local communities and conservation, which provides finance, logistics, and advice to trusted grassroots partners. ACCESS	Fly by private charter or scheduled flights to nearest airstrip (South: NDUTU & KUSINI, West: GRUMETI, North: KOGATENDE), which varies between seasons; Also reachable by safari vehicle from from other Northern camps.
CAMP	6 large walk-in safari tents including 1 family tent complete with 2 ensuite bedrooms connect by an adjoining sitting area.
CHILDREN	8+ years
HEALTH	Malaria protection is advised. Yellow fever certificate required if arriving from risk areas. Remote location with basic medical kit; medical rescue included in trip cost.

Weather

As a mobile camp, Serengeti Safari Camp follows the seasonal patterns of the Great Migration, moving between the southern, central, and northern Serengeti. Temperatures are warm year-round, with cooler mornings and evenings.

JANUARY – MARCH

16 - 28°C | 61 - 82°F

Wet season - Calving in the south; lush plains, excellent birding and predator action

APRIL – JUNE

15 - 26°C | 59 - 79°F

Long rains - Migration patterns less predictable in May during wildebeest rut; Grumeti river crossing occurs June-July.

JULY – SEPTEMBER

13 - 27°C | 55 - 81°F

Dry season - Crossings further in the north; wildlife at its peak

OCTOBER – DECEMBER

10 - 25°C | 50 - 77°F

Transitional - Camp heads back south with the herds, birding and big game excellent.



Activities & Experiences

GAME DRIVES	Morning, afternoon, and evening. Open-sided vehicle (subject to availability) Max 6 per vehicle Professional safari guides.
GAME DRIVE VEHICLE FEATURES	Three pin plug sockets & USB charging points.
WALKING SAFARIS	Get closer to the ground and observe smaller details of the bush. 1 armed Nomad scout and 1 armed ranger. Max 6 guests per walk. Guests 12+ years.
BUSH MEALS & SUNDOWNERS	Dine in the open with bush breakfasts, picnic lunches & sundowners.
WILDEBEEST MIGRATION	Seasonal camp locations provide access to calving (Dec–Mar) and river crossings (Jul–Oct).
BIRDING	Over 500 species recorded in the Serengeti; bird-focused guiding available.
STARGAZING	Remote camp locations offer clear skies for viewing stars and constellations.

North:


- Kogatende – 45+ minutes drive to camp


