OVERVIEW	6 exclusive Bushcamps in a remote and secluded part of the South Luangwa National Park, providing first-class guiding, authentic wildlife experiences, and true Zambian hospitality. Paired with a stay at Mfuwe Lodge or KuKaya, this is a true wilderness adventure.
IMPACT OF YOUR STAY	LOW MEDIUM HIGH VERY HIGH The Bushcamp Company is committed to the wildlife and people of the South Luangwa and work closely with the expanding local community and conservation organisations. Through "Charity Begins At Home," they support community initiatives including clean water access, education, meal provision, arts education, carnivore conservation, and community farming. Every guest stay contributes to park fees for Luangwa Conservation and Community Fund (LCCF) and Zambian Carnivore Program (ZCP). Additionally, a portion of revenue aids "Charity Begins at Home" initiatives, promoting sustainability and reducing carbon footprint.
ACCESS	Mfuwe International Airport (MFU) – 45-minute drive from Mfuwe Airport to Mfuwe Lodge, followed by 1.5 – 3.5 hour game drive to the Bushcamps (depending on which camp).
BUSHCAMPS	Kuyenda – 6 rondavels. Per person rate. Chamilandu – 3 chalets. Per person rate & Exclusive Use Chindeni, Kapamba, Bilimungwe, & Zungulila – 4 chalets/tents. Per person & Exclusive Use
CHILDREN	All ages are welcome, but the Bushcamps are best suited to kids 12 and up. Families with kids aged 11 or younger need to book the camps exclusively or reserve a private vehicle. Kids must be 12+ to partake in walking safaris.
HEALTH	Malaria area – seek advice from your health professional. Proof of yellow fever vaccination is required if travelling from a yellow fever area.

WEATHER

The South Luangwa region has distinct weather seasons, with a dry, cool winter from May – September, and a wet hot summer from October – April. The Bushcamps have varying open dates, but all of them closed between early Jan – early April due to the high rains.

JANUARY – MARCH
22 – 28 °C | 72 – 82 °F

The peak of the rainy season though it doesn't tend to rain all day. *All camps closed between 6 Jan – 11 April'24*.

 $18 - 28 \,^{\circ}\text{C} \mid 64 - 82 \,^{\circ}\text{F}$ The rains end and temperatures drop. Beautiful safari time with comfortable

conditions and wildlife all over the park.

APRIL – JUNE

 $17-34\,^{\circ}\text{C}$ | $63-93\,^{\circ}\text{F}$ Long dry season before the rains begin. Great time of year for walks with pleasant weather and dry conditions.

JULY – SEPTEMBER

OCTOBER – DECEMBER 24 – 36 °C | 75 – 97 °F The hottest time of the year. Wildlife congregates at the waterholes before the rains begin in November.

KUYENDA x 6	A great place to start or end your safari due to its proximity to Mfuwe, Kuyenda oozes traditional Luangwa style and charm with simple, yet authentic thatch rondavels set of the edge of a grassy plain. No two outings will be the same as you head out on foot or in vehicle, to explore diverse landscapes, including salt pans, dry riverbeds, mopane woodlands, and the Luangwa River.
CHAMILANDU x 3	An intimate camp of only 3 chalets, Chami, as it is affectionately called, is a truly magical camp set along the Luangwa River with the Chindeni Hills as your backdrop. The openstyle, stilted tree-houses welcome guests to a 180° view from which to watch the passing wildlife along the river. This camp is a great choice for photographers who can utilize the hide overlooking a waterhole, complete with a lower deck for lay-flat images at ground level. One room has a raised sala, ideal for siestas watching the river.
CHINDENI x 4	Chindeni evokes the sense of a true tented camp allowing guests to fall asleep to the sounds of the bush around them. With an enviable location on the edge of an oxbow lagoon and an expansive deck at the main area, it is not unusual for guests to opt to remain in camp and watch the wildlife come to them.

WHICH ACCOMODATION TO CHOOSE:

BILIMUNGWE X 4

Bilimungwe is the perfect spot for an armchair safari. Shaded by magnificent mahogany trees, and overlooking three active waterholes, there is always something to see whether it's the many herds of resident elephants or the abundant birdlife. Take in the sightings from the central area or from the comfort of the open thatch and reed stilted rooms. In between shows on your 'bush TV' in camp, enjoy sundowners and meals at a special spot along the river's edge.

KAPAMBA X 4

One of the only two camps open from April to January, Kapamba is a remote and romantic camp with unspoilt views across the Kapamba River. The shallow sandy river offers the perfect place to enjoy a unique sundowner experience, with your toes cooling off in the water. This camp is also the only Bushcamp with a pool, and two of the chalets have raised sleep-out salas, ideal for a cool afternoon siesta or to sleep under the stars at night.

ZUNGULILA X 4

Zungulila is the most remote of the bushcamps, and offers incredible views over the Kapamba River as well as over expansive plains where natural springs attract huge herds of game. Each of the four Meru-style tents has a private deck adorned with a spectacular bathtub, creating a comfortable and romantic setup from which to watch the passing wildlife. Walking is king from this camp with some of the most incredible and untouched wilderness just beyond the camp.


