



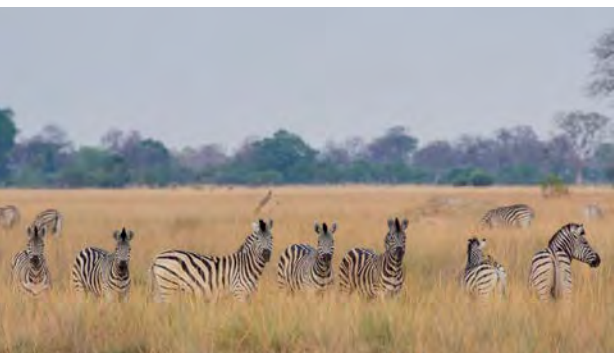

GENERAL INFORMATION

CLASSIFICATION	CLASSIC: Privately owned camp. Open all year.
LAND RELATIONSHIP	Located within the 30,000 hectare (74,000 acres) NG12 concession in the Okavango Delta, including 20 km (12.5 miles) along the Selinda Spillway.
OVERVIEW	Karangoma, rooted in Bukakhwe San and Hambukushu culture, is a partnership with a local elder from Gudingwa and is committed to making a positive impact to both the communities and wildlife that exist in this section of the Okavango Delta. The small, exclusive camp offers excellent game viewing of a wide array of species across diverse habitats, enjoyed through a range of activities, including a celebration of local Hambukushu music.
IMPACT OF YOUR STAY	LOW MEDIUM HIGH VERY HIGH Wild Expeditions Africa operates in remote African destinations, emphasizing the vital role of ecotourism in biodiversity and community engagement. In the Karangoma context, the focus is on the local rural community, tackling challenges such as crop and livestock losses through innovative cattle herding and wildlife management techniques. Each guests stay contributes through a Community & Conservation Levy, supporting NG12 community initiatives adjoining the Okavango Delta, fostering positive impacts like revenue sharing, employment, training, and celebrating traditional skills.
ACCESS	Maun (MUB) International Airport & Kasane (BBK) International Airport – scheduled charter with Wilderness Air to Vumbura airstrip Airstrip, followed by a 10 – 12 min helicopter flight to camp. Or Heli Horizons helicopter access from any camp in the delta directly to Karangoma.
CAMP	Karangoma – 5 Standard Tents & 1 Family Tent. Per person per night rate.
CHILDREN	Children 8+ years. Families with kids aged 8– 12 are required to book a private vehicle.
HEALTH	Malaria area. Seek advice from a healthcare professional.

WEATHER

The Okavango Delta has quite distinct dry and wet periods, as well as a varying seasonal flood that is dependent on the rains in Angola. This brings a wide variety of landscapes and terrain, and with it wildlife sightings and experiences, making this an exceptional year-round destination.

JANUARY – MARCH

18 – 31 °C | 64 – 87 °F

Summer rains, providing lush green landscapes, migratory birds, and new calves. Increased predator-prey interactions provides exciting viewing.

APRIL – JUNE

6 – 31 °C | 43 – 87 °F

Seasonal floods begin to fill the Delta as the weather turns cooler and drier. In addition to game drives, mokoro and boating activities are a highlight.

JULY – SEPTEMBER

6 – 33 °C | 43 – 91 °F

Cold mornings and nights, with lovely daytime temps. Great conditions for morning walks, mokoros, and boating while watching wildlife along the water.

OCTOBER – DECEMBER

18 – 37 °C | 64 – 98 °F

With higher temps and less water comes more concentrated wildlife at water sources. Rains begin in November, bringing cooling temperatures.

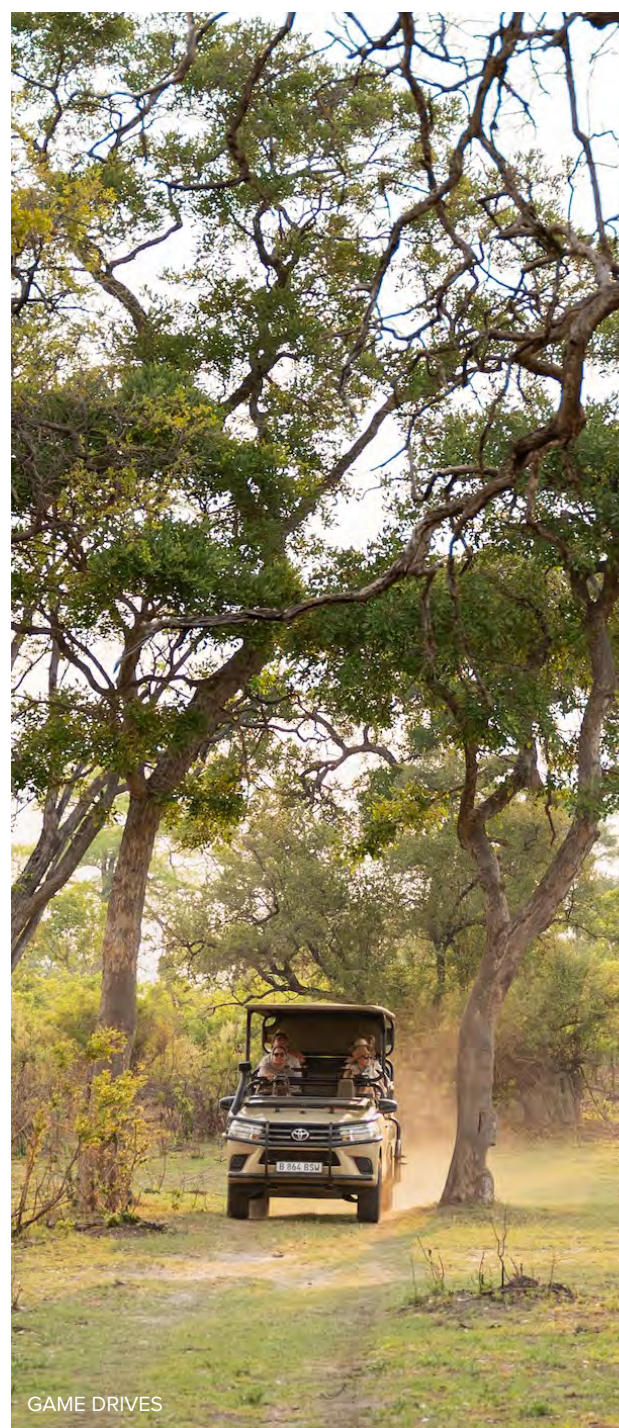

ACCESS TO KARANGOMA IS VIA HELICOPTER ONLY

- Fixed wing scheduled charter with Wilderness Air from Maun, Kasane, or another camp in the Delta to Vumbura Plains Airstrip, followed by 10 – 12 min heli flight to camp. Bookable through Wild Expeditions only.
- Karangoma private airstrip for fixed wing arrival/departures coming in 2025.
