
From dipping in the Delta, sipping coffee around a morning fire to savoring a sundowner as the earth turns from the sun, Karangoma celebrates being wild again.

The Impact of Your Stay

Wild Expeditions operates in some of the more remote and least-established destinations on the African continent. The positive impact of a viable ecotourism operation existing in areas like these on both biodiversity conservation and community engagement cannot be under-estimated. This is precisely why Wild Expeditions do operate where they do. Every guest who stays with Wild Expeditions contributes to the cause and these positive impacts simply by choosing to travel with them.

In the Karangoma context by far the most important component of conservation is the local rural community who live with wildlife and who pay the costs of doing so, regularly losing either crops to elephants or livestock to lions and other predators. Together with a local NGO, Wild Expeditions hope to introduce innovative herding and veterinary techniques to reduce stock loss and improve herd health.

Every stay contributes through:

Some of the more tangible outputs of each guests stay are outlined as follows:

- Paying US\$50 per person per night Community & Conservation Levy that directly contributes to the communities adjoining the Okavango Delta in the NG12 area.
- · Supporting Karangoma and their locals partners, the Bukakhwe San community of Gudigwa.
- This partnership focusses on positive impacts like revenue sharing, community employment, training, and hosting eco-clubs for children.
- Each stay at Karangoma supports the purpose of engaging rural communities in the value chain of ecotourism and of celebrating traditional skills ranging from the world-renowned tracking ability of the San to the appreciation for traditional instruments and music of the Bukakhwe people.
- Furthermore each guest stay supports the mitigation of human-wildlife conflict through a collaboration with the community and a local conservation NGO. The innovative cattle herding techniques and scientifically sophisticated early warning system using satellite collars placed on lions by this NGO mean that local farmers on this northern edge of the Okavango now rarely lose cattle to stock-raiding lions.
