

Fishing at Fothergill



Lake Kariba has a world-renowned reputation as a prime fishing destination. The Lake's gorges, bays, flooded forests and floodplains are rich with tilapia, Cornish Jack, Bottlenose, numerous species and subspecies of catfish, and the vundu (a catfish), and it is not uncommon to catch fish that exceed 40 pounds. Famously, Lake Kariba is a prime place to catch the formidable tigerfish species, Africa's finest freshwater fighting fish.

SEASONS

All fish can be caught year-round on the lake and the rivers, the best fishing for all species, including Tigerfish, is from September through to April, with great luck being had on live bait, spinning or even fly fishing.

ACTIVITIES

Fishing excursions can be conducted throughout the day, as well as early morning and afternoons, but is largely dependent on both the temperament of the lake and the species targeted for the day. Excursions can range in length from a couple of hours to all-day expeditions – the choice is yours!

Lake Kariba is a fisherman's paradise for experienced anglers, but also an idyllic starting point for those who have never fished before.

ACCOMMODATION



The Sanyati is one of the three largest rivers that feed Lake Kariba along its 240 kilometre length and the source of the river originates some 300 kilometres away where it weaves its ways through commercial farmland and communal areas before entering the lake through the Matusadona mountain range.

The Sanyati forms the northwestern boundary of Matusadona National Park and whilst the banks of the gorge are host to numerous species of wildlife and birds, including Osprey, Pels Fishing Owl and the iconic Fish Eagle, the deep waters hide all species of fish. Our guides come here to target both the iconic and giant Vundu as well as Tigerfish for guests.





Trips to Sanyati are recommended for the afternoons. It is approximately a 40-minute boat ride, so the trip usually departs at 15h30 from the the lodge. The gorge is quiet, mystical and brooding and even the journey should be enjoyed!
